Dear Parishioners, Alumni, and Donors:

I am pleased to report that your Education Foundation ended the 2024 fiscal year with a gain of \$295,441 over the previous year, with net assets of \$3,766,679 on June 30. I am also pleased to report the Foundation will be distributing \$144,000 to the School for the 2024/2025 school year, bringing the total distribution to \$3,015,264 since 1996. With the continued uncertainty in the markets, the level of inflation, and what actions the Federal Reserve may continue to take to stabilize the economy, the ability of your Foundation to provide yearly support to the School and continue to grow is encouraging. These results are only possible with your continued support.

A new parishioner and Foundation board member asked recently about the history of the School and Foundation. The School was formed in 1912. A new school building was built in the 1940's, and the present gym and cafeteria in the 1950's. The Education Foundation was formed in 1987 to provide a perpetual source of funding for the School, and started annual distributions to the School in 1996. Cabrini Hall was purchased in the late 1990's to provide more classroom and meeting space. In 2018 the new state of the art school building we presently enjoy was opened and the 1940's school building that sat on the corner of 17th and Monroe was torn down.

For 112 years our parish community has been supporting the faith formation and education of our children. Thanks to the foresight, faith, hard work, and love of the pastors, teachers, and parishioners that came before us, our children, grandchildren, and the entire regional community are continuing to benefit. It is the responsibility of the current generation to continue this tradition of support.

Please continue to donate to your Education Foundation. There are many ways that you can provide support to fit your situation. One option that may benefit donors over 70 years of age with an IRA is a qualified charitable distribution. This option allows the donor to make a Required Minimum Distribution from their IRA directly to the Education Foundation tax free.
